GUANTÁNAMO BAY

1. Participate in the **Guantánamo Reading Project** by putting on your own reading of *Guantanamo: Honor Bound to Defend Freedom*. Find out how, and discover more about the project, at the Center for Constitutional Rights (CCR) and the Bill of Rights Defense Committee (BORDC) websites (*see below*).
2. Write to your representatives in Congress and urge them to shut down Guantánamo and either try the remaining 540 detainees in a court of law or release them. ccr-ny.org
3. Submit an Op-Ed piece to your local newspaper about human rights abuses at Guantánamo, or organize educational events in your community to raise awareness.
4. Send a fax to Senator Edward M. Kennedy. See fax on reverse side.

CIVIL LIBERTIES IN THE U.S.

1. Join the grassroots opposition to USA PATRIOT Act extension and expansion by organizing or participating in local events during the Patriot Days of Action, July 2-8. bordc.org
2. Make your community, state, or campus a civil liberties safe zone. Encourage your religious body, organization, or union to join the national call for restoration of civil liberties. bordc.org

TORTURE AND “EXTRAORDINARY RENDITION”

1. Sign the BORDC/CCR petition against torture, detentions without charge, ghost prisoners, and extraordinary rendition at bordc.org/petition (print it out at bordc.org/threats/antitorturepetition.pdf and gather signatures in your community).
2. Write to your representatives in Congress and call on them to denounce U.S. use of torture and rendition (bordc.org/threats/torture.htm) and appoint a Special Prosecutor to conduct an independent investigation into U.S. torture (ccr-ny.org/v2/whatsnew).
